Wharf firm announces jobs boost

Canary Wharf company EA Consulting Group has announced plans for a recruitment drive.

The firm is looking to increase numbers by 40 per cent, bringing in over 100 management consultants and banking delivery professionals following an increase in business.



The majority of the roles will be in London although there will be a number across the UK.

EACG, which was formed in 1998 and is based at Marsh Wall, specialises in consultancy in the financial sector.

Executive chairman Steve Robson said: "eacg is in the business of delivering change at a fair price and in today's economic climate, change is one thing we're seeing a lot more of.
